after-school programs have seen a 40% increase in student retention and academic performance. These outcomes are only possible because of your generous support.

In the coming financial year, we will try and look for new funding avenues. We have some nice program ideas, and we also need to support actively the Reading Class program and mobile learning center. We have started Chetana project from 2018 with 3 other NGOs with the Pune Municipal Corporation's Education (Primary) Department. The initiative aims at strengthening the PMC's pre-school system through intervention in 60 PMC Schools. Any help towards finding new funding sources is highly appreciated.

Programme: Reading Class


CHILDREN: 3923 , SCHOOLS COVERED: 17

The organization has been conducting reading classes since 2006 in the municipal schools. Presently the reading classes are conducted in 17 municipal schools. A team of educators (referred to as “book fairies”) carry a large range of books with them to the school during the school hours and assist the students between the 1st and 4th grade in reading them. The book fairies go to each class once a week for one hour. The children are divided into groups based on their reading levels (reading levels are determined through a pre-test and also two post-tests are conducted to find the change in reading levels). Books are distributed as per these reading levels. In addition, several activities such as songs, stories, word games etc. are also used to build the interest of children in reading.


Objectives & Methodology:

- Encouraging children’s participation in all activities.


Children From 17 School by Class,




Level of Competence by Class at Pre-test




Level of Competence by Class at Post-test




Books/Workbooks Used by Children other than iF publication












